Distance-Learning Goals

The PSI Distance-Learning goal is to expand access to higher education opportunities for individual and community members and others through electronically offered classes. Distance learning and online teaching technology will be used to provide relevant and timely classwork, information, and activities to enhance the learning experience by removing the barriers of both time and place.

Objectives

Ministry of Education information regarding school closures

Attendance policy
